Richard Watson is an author, lecturer and scenario thinker who helps organisations to think, especially about new opportunities and risks. However, he is probably best known as a maker of <u>roadmaps</u> intended to stimulate conversation. Currently Futurist-in-Residence at the Entrepreneurship Centre at the Judge School at Cambridge University, Richard previously spent three and a half years working with the Technology Foresight Practice at Imperial College London. He is the founder of What's Next and Global Innovation Network and he co-founded GDR Creative Intelligence.

Richard is the author of five best-selling books, including *Digital Versus Human* (2016), *Future Vision: Scenarios for the World in 2040* (2013), *The Future: 50 Ideas you Really Need to Know* (2012), and *Future Files: A Brief History of the Next 50 Years* (2007).

He has also contributed chapters to a number of other books including Future Frontiers: Education in an AI World (2017), The Future of Universities (2018), After Shock (2020), A Street Through Time (2019) and The Love Makers (2021). He is currently writing two new books: one questioning our preoccupation with busyness, the other examining the impact of physical spaces on peoples' thinking, creativity and ideas.
